On January 14th, 2011, correctional officers Jateela Robinson, Sgt. Jacqueline Wright, Jarvis Braxton and Sgt. Grace Taylor discovered a non-responsive inmate who had suffered a cardiac arrest. They quickly provided emergency treatment to the inmate and were assisted by medical staff. The inmate was revived and then transported to Southern Regional Medical Center in Riverdale.

**ADAP- ALCOHOL AND DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAM**

In Georgia, teens between the ages of 15 and 17 are required by law to show proof that they have completed ADAP in order to obtain their Class D driver's license.

This course is provided once a month on a select Wednesday from 4PM to 8 PM at no cost to participants. The class is held at the Sheriff's Office Headquarters and proctored by deputies.

Registration for the month of March is closed.

Maximum number of students per class is 40. Prior registration is required. No walk-ins accepted. Participants must bring a valid picture id.
